Land of the Bible

My more immediate ancestors lived in a little village in central eastern Turkey before coming to the U. S. nearly 100 years ago. Now strictly an archaeological site, Harpoot was built into the side of a mountain. This allowed residents to enjoy the benefits of natural fortification not available to my more *distant* ancestors.

These ancient ones were the Assyrians. Like many indigenous peoples, we were wrenched from the heart of our ancestral homeland which lay along the open plains within Mesopotamia. That "land between the two rivers" framed by the Tigris and Euphrates, is what historians call the *Fertile Crescent*, where the oil-rich land of Iraq is today.

What would Jesus say ...

The language of my people is Aramaic. It was also the language Christ spoke and at that time in history, the dominant conversational tongue throughout the Middle East.

I note with some irony that Aramaic is considered a "dead" language. In this particular season of "peace and goodwill," we witness the heartbreaking breach between the authentic message of Christ and the living culture of war, deception, greed and illwill that demands our attention, propels our actions and consumes our consciousness, frequently in His name. Those who would "lead" us, capitalize on perpetuating fear by mounting sophisticated deceptions. while manipulating us towards a war that will surely lead to increased violence of horrific proportion.

Peace on earth ...?

I believe in the human capacity for goodwill and our ability to live in harmony. I am a mediator in actual practice and at heart. But I cannot stand idlely and sing about" peace on earth" this Christmas, without acknowledging my deep awareness that we are perilously poised for an unprecedented leap into just the opposite.

The truth is the truth ...

The one from Mum speaks of what we might hold in our heart, the source of all truth: "Faith is the bird that feels the light and sings when the dawn is dark."

The one from Dad addresses *action,* on both the literal and metaphorical levels.

"Light a candle and curse the darkness."

Perhaps these may be the "times that try men's souls." With certainty, these are the times that call us to anchor ourselves in our faith, to reach for the light ... to listen for the truth, align ourselves *with* it, and *speak* it.
